## **JUNE Highlights**

Father's Day is a celebration honoring fathers and celebrating fatherhood, paternal bonds, and the influence of fathers in society.

Father's Day is celebrated worldwide to recognize the contribution that fathers and father figures make to the lives of their children.

**End of year assessments** are wrapping up. Most students have been tested with the REACH Assessment and TRC/DiBELS for Kindergarten and 1st and NWEA for 2<sup>nd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> grades.

"I'M PROMPT AND PRESENT – COUNT ME IN" is an end of school year attendance incentive program designed to change the view of attendance in both students and parents. We hope to instill a sense of priority in each child and family member to be prompt and present daily. More than 5% of our students are absent daily and the tardy rate has jumped to 20%. Attendance is a key factor in student success and more students will achieve because they are prompt and present! This program will start on May 1<sup>st</sup> and end on June 20<sup>th</sup>.

We are pushing for one day of **PERFECT ATTENDANCE IN THE WHOLE BUILDING!** When we accomplish this task we will be out of uniform for the rest of the school year! Help us!!
